The New York City Campaign Finance Board (the “Board”) has completed its review of your independent spending reported during the 2021 election cycle. One issue was noted.

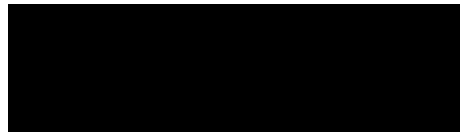
No invoice was provided for the phone bank expenditure related to your robocall communication distributed on 6/21/21 titled *Robo call 2 - Yeshiva graduate*. Missing expenditure documentation makes it impossible to determine the accuracy of your reporting for this expenditure.

Notwithstanding the above, based on a review of documents submitted and information disclosed during the 2021 election cycle the Board has determined that Voters for Substantial Equivalency demonstrated substantial compliance with the New York City Charter and Board Rules.

This concludes our review and a response to this letter is not required. Please retain for three years records of any communication, expenditure, or contribution that you determined was not reportable in case questions arise in the future. Material already submitted need not be retained.
